COLLEEN WASINGER NAMED “CITIZEN OF THE YEAR” BY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

Town & Country Alderman Colleen Wasinger has been honored with the 2006 Citizen of the Year Award from the Town & Country/Frontenac Chamber of Commerce.

Her accomplishment was also recognized by the St. Louis County Council and the City of Town & Country in resolutions unanimously approved by both governmental bodies. Wasinger is a Republican candidate for the St. Louis County Council in the Third District in the August 8th election.

In making their selection for Citizen of the Year, the Chamber said Wasinger has “quickly earned the reputation as one whom giving back to the community is second nature and has become one of the best examples of how pride in one’s community and willingness to work to improve it can lead to a better life for all.”
